### **Communication:**

Each week an e-mail is sent to all parents/carers detailing important events that will be occurring in the school for the following week. We update our website regularly and all Parent Evenings dates are found on the school calendar. We are also extending the use of SchoolComms system and will be able to inform you electronically details of your daughter's reports, attendance certificates, timetables and examination timetables. 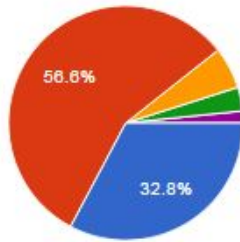
### **Homework:**

We provide each student with a homework timetable at the beginning of the year and we now use Show My Homework enabling students to access the homework from their mobile phones or computers. Not all homework issued needs to be printed off but the students have access to the instructions to complete it. Homework is necessary and students should be encouraged to read over their work they have completed each day to ensure consolidation.

### **Behaviour:**

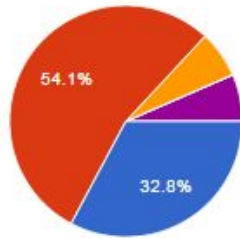

We deal very swiftly with students who disrupt others learning by removing them from a lesson to allow the rest of the class to continue learning. **1. My daughter is happy at Reading Girls' School**



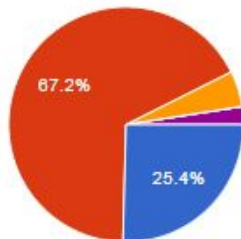

**2. My daughter feels safe at Reading Girls' School**



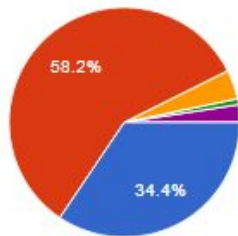
